Explore paradise, safely...

As children grow, how they sit in a car will change. Make sure you use a car seat that fits your child's current size and age.



INFANT SEATS 0-2 years / 2-10 kg

Rear-facing. The best seat for your infant or young child to use. It has a harness and, in a crash, cradles and moves with your infant to reduce the stress to the infant's fragile neck and spinal cord. Never install in the front seat, nor place any extra padding between your child and the harness straps. In a crash these will compress and your child may slip out. Retainer clip should be at armpit level.



CONVERTIBLE SEATS 1-4 years / 2-22 kg

This seat can change from a rearfacing seat to a forward-facing seat with a harness and tether. Children below 2 years are recommended to face backwards. Harness straps should be snug, and the retainer clip at armpit level. When facing forward, the tether strap should be hooked to a designated anchor point and harness straps at, or above, the child's shoulders.



BOOSTER SEATS 4-11 years / 18-36 kg

Forward-facing only. Recommended for all children under 8 years / 1,4 m. This seat raises and positions a child so the vehicle's lap-and-shoulder belt fits properly over the stronger points of the child's body (the hips and across the chest). Booster seats require a lap AND shoulder belt - they are not designed to be used with a lap belt only (middle seat).
