CREOLE CUISINE:

A Taste of Paradise

Seychelles' Creole cuisine is a fusion of African, Indian, Chinese, French, and British culinary traditions. The cuisine developed over centuries as a result of the island's history of colonization and the intermingling of cultures. The Seychellois people developed their cuisine by adapting to their tropical environment and using locally available ingredients and spices to create unique and flavourful dishes.

Authentic 'Kreol' cuisine is based on seafood, as the islands are surrounded by the Indian Ocean. Fish and shellfish are staples in Seychellois cuisine, and dishes such as octopus curry, grilled fish, and bouillon are popular. Fish and poultry is often cooked in coconut milk and served with rice and lentils, called "riz-grains."

Another essential element in Seychellois cuisine is the use of spices, as for many years the islands were not serviced with electricty and food needed to be spiced or salted as a preservative. Today, Creole cuisine incorporates a variety of spices, such as ginger, garlic, cumin, turmeric, coriander, saffron and cinnamon, to name a few. These spices give Seychellois cuisine its distinct, piquant flavour.

The Seychelles also has a variety of local fruits such as papaya, mangoes, and bananas, which are used to create refreshing fruit salads, desserts and drinks.

The historical development of Seychellois cuisine can be traced back to the 18th century when French colonisers brought their culinary traditions to the islands. Later, when the British colonised the islands in the 19th century, they introduced Indian and Chinese cuisines to the islands' culinary repertoire.

In the 20th century, Seychelles gained independence from the British, and the Seychellois people began to embrace their Creole identity. Creole cuisine became a symbol of the islands' cultural heritage. Today, Seychellois cuisine continues to evolve, with local chefs creating innovative dishes that blend traditional Creole ingredients and flavours with modern cooking techniques.






